



**SQ14 OPERATING INSTRUCTION 10-01**  
**12 APRIL 2010**  
**Cadet Programs**  
**Senior Member Supervision of Cadet Activities**

This instruction describes the local procedures concerning Senior Members supervising cadet activities at Squadron 14.

1. In accordance with CAPR 56-12, Cadet Program Management, Senior Members will be present at all activities involving cadets. The cadets will be within line of sight of at least one supervising Senior Member at all times.
2. Senior Members supervising the cadets will take all reasonable measures necessary to protect cadets from harm while under CAP supervision in accordance with CAPR 52-10, Cadet Protection Policy.
3. Senior Members directly supervising cadets, in any capacity, must complete the Cadet Protection Program Training (CPPT), as recorded in e-Services at [www.capnhq.gov](http://www.capnhq.gov). One of the supervising Senior Members must have at least one of the following qualifications:
  - 1 year as a Cadet
  - 1 year as a Cadet Programs Officer or a Technician Rating in Cadet Programs.
  - Squadron Safety Officer, Assistant Squadron Safety Officer or a Technician Rating in Safety.
4. Senior Members providing supervision for cadets must immediately notify the Squadron Commander and Deputy Commander for Cadets of any mishap.
